



Special note to members of the U.S. Armed Forces who are eligible for DANTES funding for their educational program.

This report has been prepared for all Design for Leadership current and prospective students (July 2009).

The Defiance College DESIGN for LEADERSHIP has been accepted by DANTES (The Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support) for the education of chaplains' assistants and others eligible for DANTES funding who wish to learn more about Christian Religious Education.

The application process for entering the program is the same. Once accepted into the program, students in the military send in a **course registration with full payment for tuition**, plus a **DANTES Distance Learning Enrollment Form for Service Members**. The latter form must be obtained from an education officer in the student's branch of the Armed Forces, and signed by that officer, an education services specialist, a guidance counselor, or the student's commanding officer.

When the student completes a course, the DESIGN for LEADERSHIP office sends DANTES a copy of the student's reported grade along with the appropriate copy of the original DANTES form submitted with the registration. At that time DANTES reimburses part or all of the tuition directly to the student. Contact your education officer for current tuition assistance policies.

NOTE: DANTES will only provide tuition assistance reimbursement upon course completion.
