

UNDERGRADUATE GRADUATION APPLICATION & INFORMATION

The attached form is your formal application for graduation and it provides information for the commencement program and ordering caps, gowns, diplomas and parental and honorary alumni certificates. **You must complete and submit the application to be considered for graduation.**

If you will complete your degree requirements in December 2011, you need to complete an application for graduation and turn it in to the Registrar's Office by May 2, 2011. It is important that we have your application prior to the fall 2011 semester, so your name can be presented to the Board of Trustees and faculty in early fall. We can then release a diploma to you shortly after grades are reported for the fall semester if all coursework is completed. If you fail to apply for graduation by the deadline and thus, are not approved by the faculty and Board of Trustees in the fall, your diploma will be awarded at the May 2012 commencement ceremony.

If you complete the attached application and qualify for graduation, you will be placed on the graduation list and receive a letter in March from the Academic Dean's Office that will outline details about the graduation ceremony and events of that day. Only those students with nine hours or less remaining to be taken in summer may be approved for summer graduation. Summer graduates must schedule remaining coursework needed in the subsequent summer session(s) at Defiance College by April 1st or the student will be dropped from the graduation list.

The 2012 graduation ceremonies are scheduled for Sunday, May 6. The time and location will be determined in January 2012. For planning purposes you should know that we usually hold a baccalaureate service in the morning at 10:30 am and commencement at 12:00 noon. Parental Alumni and Honorary Certificates

The parental alumni and honorary alumni certificates are documents signed by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and the President of the College, and they are presented to parents, spouse, guardians, or friends "...whose encouragement, devotion, and sacrifice have made possible the completion of all requirements set forth by the college for a degree which is awarded this day to (your name)..." The certificate is a thank you to someone who has helped you. There is no charge for these certificates. If you request one (or more) it will be enclosed with your diploma.

Graduation Announcement, Caps and Gowns

To order a cap and gown, please complete Part IX on the application. (If you've already ordered or have a cap and gown, please check the "already have/borrowed" box or the "already ordered" box.) There will be a fee for the cap and gown and they will be yours to keep after the ceremony. The College Bookstore will have graduation announcements available in the spring.
