*Wendy Pestrue leads the Institutional Advancement team following the retirement of vice president Rich Rejeau*



She comes to Defiance from Philadelphia where she has been the senior director of development for clinical programs at Temple University School of Medicine. Previously, she was director of grateful patient fundraising with The Ohio State University School of Medicine.
